R&B Legend, Smokey Robinson at Wind Creek Casino

Atmore, AL (March 24, 2010) –R&B legend Smokey Robinson will be performing at the Amphitheater at Wind Creek on Saturday, May 15, 2010 at 9:00 p.m. Tickets are on sale now at Essentials Gift Shoppe in the Wind Creek Casino & Hotel or tickets are available online at Ticketmaster.com, and at all Ticketmaster Outlets.



One of the most successful songwriters of all time, Smokey Robinson is most recognized for his role as the lead singer for the Matadors, the soulful R&B group he formed in the early 50's. Smokey's Matadors soon became known as the famous Miracles that soared to the top of the billboard charts. The Miracles scored their first big hit with "Shop Around" (1960) and developed quite a following with their energetic R&B sound. The group has numerous hits, including "You Really Got a Hold on Me" (1962) and "I Second That Emotion" (1967). Robinson also worked behind the scenes, composing and producing for the Miracles and other Motown artists, such as Mary Wells and the Temptations. His work contributed to the success of Motown Records and helped advance the popularity of soul music. Robinson went on to win his first Grammy Award as a solo artist in 1987 for Best R&B Vocal Performance, Male, for the song "Just To See Her" from the album One Heartbeat. Other later solo recordings included Double Good Everything (1991) and Intimate (1999). He took his work in a new direction in 2004, releasing a collection of music that reflected his spiritual beliefs entitled Food for the Spirit.
